Theme: Live to Serve-Honoring Our Methodist Heritage

Bible Text: Psalm 100:2 Serve the Lord with Gladness; Come before His presence with singing!

After arriving in La Paz, perched in the Andes over 12,000 feet above sea level, we will visit with women leaders from 18 districts of the Iglesia Evangélica Metodista in Bolivia (IEMB). We'll meet in Ancoraimes on Lake Titicaca (Lake District), and the women from different regions will travel to join us.



Our work is focused on women who, for cultural and social reasons, are in marginal situations with no possibility of access to education or training to improve their quality of life. This reality is mainly seen in rural and suburb areas of main Bolivian cities. It is these sisters we support with the invaluable contributions of the sister organizations who support our projects. We conduct workshops on topics that help the formation of personal, spiritual and material growth. Typical subjects include leadership, self-esteem, discrimination, violence against women, planning, administration, evaluation, machine and hand knitting, sewing, embroidery, and handicrafts. In the last three years, we have started to introduce the women to

technology with computer workshops. We are eager to share and learn with our sisters from the UMW.

Goals:

- Visit and learn about the Tabitha's House project.
- Learn about the deep heritage of the IEMB and the important role women have in the church.
- Enjoy sharing many cultural experiences together.
- Learn the Bolivian way of preserving potatoes! This tuber is originally from these Andean mountains.
- Discuss the importance of serving and tithing.
- Share devotionals, songs and prayer together.
- Experience joy and happiness in three languages!
